Agreement for Landscape Inclusive with Florida Department of

Transportation

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing execution of the Second Amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for Exhibit 1.

Background

In December of 2007, the City entered into an agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the purpose of the City maintaining the landscape improvements on various roads including State Road 838 (Sunrise Boulevard). The second amendment allows for ROW improvements as part of Paseo del Mar site plan that was approved by the Planning and Zoning Board on August 15th, 2012.

The City's Complete Street guidelines suggest that the landscaping in the State's ROW provide a buffer between the vehicle travel lanes and the pedestrian path. Paseo del Mar has agreed to provide and maintain these improvements as per their site plan approval. Well maintained landscaping on Sunrise Boulevard also enhances the City's identity and appearance.

Staff recommends the resolution to approve the second amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement for Landscape Inclusive with Florida Department of Transportation.
