A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A FIRST AMENDMENT TO CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FY 2022 NOT FOR PROFIT SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND TASKFORCE FORE ENDING HOMELESSNESS, INC., FOR THE FORT LAUDERDALE HOUSING NAVIGATION PROGRAM, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City and the Participant wish to expand the services that the Participant provides to the City to benefit the City's homeless population;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves a First Amendment to City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2022 Not for Profit Service Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Taskforce Fore Ending Homelessness, Inc., ("First Amendment"), in substantially the form attached to City Commission Agenda Memo #23-1045, and authorizes execution of the First Amendment.
