

RESOLUTION NO. 17-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FIRST ONE YEAR EXTENSION TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DOWNTOWN FORT LAUDERDALE TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION FOR COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE AND TRANSIT SERVICES, WITH AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF OCTOBER 1, 2017.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida (the "City") and the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association ("TMA") are currently in an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") to operate the City Community Bus services; and

WHEREAS, the City defines the terms and conditions for the TMA to provide Community Bus and transit services within the City, on behalf of the City and in compliance with the terms and conditions as set forth in the October 1, 2014 Interlocal Agreement for Community Bus Services, entered between the City and Broward County; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement will expire on September 30, 2017 with a base term of three years and with two additional one year extension options; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Interlocal Agreement with the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association for an additional one (1) year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to execute the First

one year Extension of the Interlocal Agreement with Downtown Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association, with an effective date of October 1, 2017.

SECTION 2. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by the City Manager.
