TITLE: Motion to Approve Architectural Design and Construction Administration of Fire Station No. 54 – Pierce Goodwin Alexander & Linville, Inc. - \$280,159

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract for the architectural design and construction administration services of Fire Station No. 54 to Pierce Goodwin Alexander & Linville, Inc. (PGAL), in substantially the form attached, at a cost of \$280,159.

Background

On May 5, 2015 (CAM 15-0488), the City Commission approved the final ranking and commencement of contract negotiations for architectural design and construction administration services of the new Fire Station No. 54 with the top ranked proposer PGAL. Staff has completed negotiations with the consultant and is now requesting approval to award the contract. The scope of services includes, but is not limited to, the design, bidding services, and post-design construction administration services.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$280,159 for the contract and \$175,000 for in-house project management fees, or a total amount of \$455,159.
