TITLE: 2nd reading - Approve an Ordinance Amending the Name of the Middle
River – South Middle River – Sunrise Blvd Redevelopment Area
(MRSMRSB) Redevelopment Advisory Board to the “Central City
Redevelopment Advisory Board”

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the second reading of an ordinance amending the name of the Middle River – South Middle River – Sunrise Blvd Redevelopment Advisory Board to the “Central City Redevelopment Advisory Board”.

Background

On December 5, 2012 MRSMRSB Redevelopment Advisory Board voted to change the name of the redevelopment area to the Central City Redevelopment Area. In order to make this change two ordinances need to be adopted and a resolution passed to make name changes to the advisory board, the redevelopment trust fund and redevelopment plan to be consistent with the general name change request.

The ordinance attached to this agenda memorandum officially amends the name of the Redevelopment Advisory board from the Middle-River-South Middle River-Sunrise Blvd Redevelopment Advisory Board to the “Central City Redevelopment Advisory Board”.
