TITLE: Resolution Imposing Special Assessment Liens for Graffiti Removal -

(Commission Districts 3 and 4)

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission consider approving a resolution authorizing the imposition of special assessment liens for costs associated with the removal of graffiti from properties listed in Exhibit 1.

### **Background**

As authorized by sections 18-14 and 18-15 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale (Code), the City removed graffiti from the properties listed in Exhibit 1. The exhibit shows actual costs and expenses associated with abating the nuisance(s). Costs associated with the removal of graffiti will be recorded against the respective properties as a special assessment lien in the public records of Broward County.

Section 18-13 of the Code requires the property owner to remove the graffiti from the property within ten days of the date of a citation. When compliance is not achieved within the required timeframe, a City designated contractor clears the property of the nuisances. The Community Enhancement and Compliance Division then mails a statement of assessed costs and expenses to the property owner requesting payment within 30 days.

If the City does not receive payment on the outstanding balance within 30 days from the date of the mailing, the Community Enhancement and Compliance Division shall record the case in the public records of Broward County.

## **Resource Impact**

Should the City receive payment on the outstanding balance, the City will recover \$3,234 spent on graffiti removal services, plus any interest that accrues before the City receives payment from the property owner.
