**TITLE**: Resolution to Correct a Scrivener's Error

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution amending Resolution No. 08-63 to correct a scrivener's error.

## **Background**

On April 1, 2008, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 08-63 vacating the 15-foot utility easement retained over the vacated alley in Block 1, "Amended Plat of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33 of North Lauderdale" subject to certain conditions. The title of the Resolution No. 08-63 incorrectly identified "Block 1, 'Amended Plat of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33 of North Lauderdale'" as "Block 182, 'North Lauderdale,'" however, the vacated easement was corrected identified in the legal description attached as Exhibit to and made part of Resolution No. 08-63. Attached is a proposed resolution to correct the above scrivener's error.
