

RESOLUTION NO. 13-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT THROUGH THE CITY OF MIAMI FY2011 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT PROGRAM; AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO ACCEPT SUCH GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has provided financial assistance to the Miami urban area in the amount of \$9,356,839 through the FY2011 UASI Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the urban area is defined as the Miami and Fort Lauderdale area collectively; and

WHEREAS, the sponsoring and coordinating agency for the grant is the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale has received a sub-grant in the amount of \$236,818.42 with no required match; and

WHEREAS, such grant funds will be used towards enhancements to the communications infrastructure, Community Emergency Response Team training and equipment and Emergency Operations Center enhancements and maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the proper City Officials are hereby authorized to accept grant funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management in the amount of \$236,818.42 via the City of Miami.
