Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution delegating the authority to the City Manager to execute a Project Agreement (ICW-BR-FL-23-02) between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) providing funding from FIND in the amount up to \$4,275, but in no event more than 75% of the City's out of pocket costs, ("Project Amount") for the removal of an abandoned derelict 28' Carver motor yacht from the Cox's Landing Boat Ramp (hereinafter "Project") and authorizing the City Manager to execute the agreement any other documents reasonably necessary and ancillary to the implementation and completion of the Project Agreement and Project. This Grant requires a city match of \$1,425.

Background

The Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) administers the Waterway Assistance Program (WAP) program. FIND provides funding assistance to local governments within the District to provide public access to area waterways through boat ramps, floating docks and derelict vessel removal.

A 28' vessel was abandoned at the Cox's Landing Boat Ramp and the City of Fort Lauderdale Police Marine Unit deemed the vessel abandon and authorized the City to remove the vessel on September 25, 2023. On October 12, 2023, Sea Tow Fort Lauderdale removed and disposed of the derelict vessel for the City at a cost of \$5,700.

The Florida Inland Navigation District Small Scale Derelict Vessel Removal Program will fund up to 75%, or in this case \$4,275 of the costs needed to salvage and properly dispose of this abandoned vessel. The remaining costs of \$1,425 to remove the vessel will be funded by the City.

Resource Impact

This action will result in a positive impact to the City in the amount of \$4,275 which will be appropriated to the accounts below contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 24-0035.
