

RESOLUTION NO. 23-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, LEVYING A NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 ON BEHALF OF THE LAUDERDALE ISLES WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT AND APPROVING THE BUDGET FOR THE DISTRICT.

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WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale is empowered to levy and collect for the benefit of the Lauderdale Isles Water Management District (hereinafter "District") a non-ad valorem special assessment on property located within the boundaries of said District; and

WHEREAS, the District adopted a resolution determining that the District's expenses and cost of maintaining the canals should be specially assessed against all properties within the District abutting on the canals because of the benefit received from the work of the district that was reaffirmed by Resolution R-03-1; and

WHEREAS, said District has submitted to the City Commission the budget of the District as approved by the Board of said District for its calendar year beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2024, a copy of said budget being attached hereto as Appendix 1 and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, said approved budget requires the levying of a \$15.00 non-ad valorem special assessment per parcel on the taxable property abutting a canal within the boundary of said District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale hereby levies on all real property abutting on the canals and lying within the "District," a non-ad valorem special assessment of \$15.00 per parcel for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2024, for the purposes for which the District was created.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale hereby approves the budget for the District for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023, and ending September 30, 2024.

SECTION 3. That such non-ad valorem special assessment shall be certified by the City Clerk to the Broward County Property Appraiser, the Broward County Records, Taxes & Treasury Division and the Department of Revenue of the State of Florida, by delivering a certified copy of this Resolution to each.

SECTION 4. That this resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.
