

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a construction agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the Fort Lauderdale Beach Park Parking Lot Improvements, with Sagaris Corp. (Sagaris), to include an additional 205 days and \$69,101.50.

#### Background

On June 9, 2023, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 130-10 – Fort Lauderdale Beach Park Parking Lot Improvements. On October 3, 2023 the City Commission considered CAM #23-0894 (Exhibit 1), and approved a construction agreement with Sagaris to complete the milling and resurfacing project for a total of \$559,712.00 (Exhibit 2). Sagaris received a Notice to Proceed (NTP) on January 8, 2024. The NTP identified that the project would be completed in 275 days. On October 3, 2024, Change Order No. 1 (Exhibit 3) was issued for time only to include an additional 90 days moving the completion date from October 9, 2024 to January 7, 2025.

In January 2025, Sagaris informed City staff that there were issues relating to an electrical service line connection and components that were not included in the initial ITB. This caused delays in procuring the compatible materials. Multiple exchanges between the designer of record and Sagaris were exchanged, and compatible components were identified. In addition, there were delays pertaining to a new sidewalk design that required stakeholder and Public Works Department input, coordination and approval, which was obtained at the end of January 2025.

Components valued in the amount of \$69,101.50 are included in the construction agreement (Exhibit 4) in order to complete the electrical scope of work.

The agreement will be retroactive to January 7, 2025. Staff recommends the Commission approve the agreement with Sagaris Corp. under the same terms and conditions of the original agreement. If approved, the new agreement will add 205 days to the project timeline and establish July 31, 2025 as the project final completion date.

#### Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$69,101.50 for this construction agreement. Funds are available in the FY 2025 Budget/CIP in the account listed below:

# CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT FOR

#### FORT LAUDERDALE BEACH PARK PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENTS

THIS CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") for Fort Lauderdale Beach Park Parking Lot Improvements made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2025, is by and between the City of Fort Lauderdale, a Florida municipal corporation ("City"), whose address is 101 NE 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Suite 2100, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301, and Sagaris Corp., a Florida profit corporation ("Contractor"), whose principal address is 3660 NW 126<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Bay 6, Coral Springs, Florida 33065 (individually as "Party" or collectively as "Parties").

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida at its meeting of October 3, 2023, authorized the proper officials by motion to execute an Agreement between Contractor and City authorizing the performance of construction services for the Fort Lauderdale Beach Park Parking Lot Improvements at Fort Lauderdale Beach Park Parking Lot, Invitation to Bid (ITB) Event No. 130-10, Project No. 12513, in the amount of \$559,712.00 ("Original Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the time for the performance of services was negotiated by the City and Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the scheduled project completion date was 275 calendar days from the Notice to Proceed issued on January 8, 2024; and

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2024, Change Order Number 1 was issued to add 90 additional days to the final completion date; and

WHEREAS, due to the delays with Florida Power & Light's new, electrical service line connection and electrical components that were no longer being manufactured, as required by the design package, the Original Agreement expired on January 7, 2025; and

WHEREAS, compatible replacement materials have been identified; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are desirous of completing the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to include an additional 205 calendar days to advance the project to completion and wish to increase the Not to Exceed Compensation Amount by Sixty-Nine Thousand One Hundred One Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$69,101.50), as compensation for the performance of Contractor's services, subject to the same terms, conditions and specifications contained in the Original Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto, in consideration of the mutual covenants, agreements, terms, and conditions contained herein, do agree as follows:

- 1.1 The recitations set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated by reference herein. Initial capitalized terms or other such terms used herein shall have the same meaning given such terms in the Original Agreement, unless otherwise defined herein or unless the context otherwise indicates.
- 1.2 The Original Agreement and all terms and conditions of the Original Agreement except as modified herein, are incorporated into and made part of this Agreement and are attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 1.3 This Agreement will be retroactive to January 7, 2025.
- 1.4 The Contract Time as defined in the Original Agreement shall be understood to also include the period of time from the termination of the Original Agreement to the time of execution of this Agreement.
- 1.5 Section 5.3 of the Original Agreement is hereby deleted and replaced with: "The Work shall be finally completed on the Final Completion Date within Two Hundred and Five (205) calendar days from January 7, 2025."
- The Not to Exceed Amount of Compensation reflected in 6.2 of the Original Agreement is increased by Sixty-Nine Thousand One Hundred One Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$69,101.50), as compensation for the performance of Contractor's services, subject to the same terms, conditions and specifications contained in the Original Agreement.


