

RESOLUTION NO. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE HONORARY DESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF STATE ROAD 842/EAST LAS OLAS BOULEVARD BETWEEN SOUTH ANDREWS AVENUE AND SOUTHEAST 6TH AVENUE IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AS "TERRY STILES MEMORIAL BOULEVARD," AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Subsection (7) of version S 628 of Senate Bill 628 in the 2026 Florida Legislature, which was signed into law on April 14, 2026, and became effective on July 1, 2026, provides that "[t]hat portion of S.R. 842/East Las Olas Boulevard between South Andrews Avenue and S.E. 6th Avenue in Broward County is designated as "Terry Stiles Memorial Boulevard."; and

WHEREAS, the Florida House of Representatives' nonpartisan committee staff prepared a Final Bill Analysis, citing 11 Miami Herald: Developer Terry Stiles Dies at Age 70 After Battle with Cancer, <https://www.miamiherald.com/news/local/obituaries/article174524526.html> (last visited March 16, 2026), which reads:

"Terry Stiles was a prominent developer from Ft. Lauderdale and head of the Stiles Corporation. Stiles was credited with helping shape Ft. Lauderdale's skyline and known for his many charitable contributions to the Broward County community. Stiles passed away on September 11, 2017."

and

WHEREAS, Subsection 334.071(3), Florida Statutes (2025), provides, in part, that "[e]rection of markers shall be contingent on the appropriate city or county commission passing a resolution in support of the particular honorary designation."; and

WHEREAS, that portion of State Road 842/East Las Olas Boulevard between South Andrews Avenue and Southeast 6th Avenue is located within the corporate limits of the City of Fort Lauderdale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission supports the honorary designation of "[t]hat portion of S.R. 842/East Las Olas Boulevard between South Andrews Avenue and S.E. 6th Avenue in the

City of Fort Lauderdale, Broward County, Florida, as "Terry Stiles Memorial Boulevard."

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final adoption.
