TITLE Motion to Approve Contracts for Purchase of Streetlight Fixtures – World
Electric Supply Inc., Torres Electrical Supply Company, Inc. - \$200,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve one-year contracts, in substantially the forms attached, for the purchase of streetlight fixtures from World Electric Supply Inc. and Torres Electrical Supply Company, Inc. in the estimated aggregate amount of \$200,000; and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one-year renewal options contingent upon approval and appropriation of funds.

Background

The Parks and Recreation Department uses these streetlight fixtures to replace worn out fixtures and mast arms. This contract includes all Light Emitting Diode (LED) fixtures because the current high pressure sodium (HPS) fixtures in place are being phased out by the manufacturer. The LED fixtures are more efficient and last longer than the HPS fixtures.

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12180-592 and received six bids. World Electric Supply Inc. was the low responsive and responsible bidder for line items 1 thru 12 as identified in Exhibit 2. Low bidders Mayer Electric Supply Company, Inc., GonLED, and “D” Electrician Technical Services Inc. did not meet the technical specifications for line item 13. The next lowest bidder, Torres Electrical Supply Company, Inc. has met the specifications and has been deemed the low responsive and responsible bidder for line item 13 as identified in Exhibit 2.

Resource Impact

There will be no fiscal impact to the City in FY 2018. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.

Strategic Connections

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included with in the Public Places Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 3: Be a community that finds opportunities and leverages partnerships to create unique, inviting, and connected gathering places that highlight our beaches, waterways, urban areas and parks.
- Objective 1: Improve access to and enjoyment of our beach, Riverwalk, waterways, parks, and open spaces for everyone.

This item advances the *Fast Forward Fort Lauderdale Vision Plan 2035: We Are United*.
