

RESOLUTION NO. 15-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND CYNTHIA A. EVERETT, PROVIDING FOR A THREE PERCENT MERIT SALARY INCREASE FOR CITY ATTORNEY CYNTHIA A. EVERETT, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 13-104 the City Commission approved an Employment Contract with Cynthia A. Everett to serve as City Attorney; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney and the City Commission have reached agreement on a First Amendment to Employment Contract between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Cynthia A. Everett; and

WHEREAS, the Employment Contract between the City of Fort Lauderdale and City Attorney Cynthia A. Everett provides that the City “may grant merit increases to such extent as the City may determine that it is desirable to do so on the basis of an annual performance review”; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that based on her annual performance review, City Attorney Cynthia A. Everett merits a salary increase,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the First Amendment to Employment Contract between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Cynthia A. Everett is hereby approved in substantially the form attached, and the City Commission authorizes Mayor John P. “Jack” Seiler to execute the First Amendment to Employment Contract between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Cynthia A. Everett.

SECTION 2. That City Attorney Cynthia A. Everett’s annual base salary is increased by three percent effective July 1, 2015.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
