**TITLE:** Consent Resolution approving reappointment of Code Enforcement  
Special Magistrates

The Code Enforcement Division of the Department of Sustainable Development is requesting that Judge Mark Purdy and Rose Anne Flynn, Esq, be reappointed as Special Magistrates for a period of time ending March 01, 2014.

Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale was adopted to promote, protect and improve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Fort Lauderdale by the creation of a code enforcement system. The Code of Ordinances establishes the utilization of Special Magistrates for hearing cases involving violations of municipal codes.

Currently Judge Mark Purdy and Rose Anne Flynn, Esq. serve as the Special Magistrates for the City and will continue to hear cases pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 11 of the code of Ordinance of the City of Fort Lauderdale.
