TITLE: Resolution Amending the FY 2014 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and

associated budget

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2014 Community Investment Plan and associated budget.

## **Background**

The Community Investment Plan (CIP) is funded from multiple funding sources and consists of hundreds of projects. It is necessary to modify the CIP and project budgets to meet the City's current prioritized needs and to close projects that are no longer being pursued. Projects that are no longer being pursued will be removed from the Five-Year CIP and its funding transferred to fund balances or used for other priority projects.

### **Public Works**

A. Transfer of funds from the Marshall's Point Bridge Noise Mitigation project to fund balance and closing the project. – General Capital Projects Fund - \$151,941

According to the Public Works Department, the Broward County Bridge Division indicates that this project was completed approximately a year ago. Therefore, the funding appropriated to this project can be transferred to the General Capital Projects fund balance.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2014 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the General Capital Projects Fund in the amount of \$151,941.

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### **Sustainable Development**

- B. Unappropriated capital project budgets Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights (NWPFH) CRA Bond Fund close projects \$990,214
- C. Appropriation from fund balance Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Area (CRA) Fund to Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights CRA CIP Fund funding for ongoing projects \$862,061
- D. Appropriation from fund balance Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights CRA CIP Fund funding for ongoing projects \$662,061

In 2004, the Community Redevelopment Area (CRA) issued Tax Increment Revenue (TIR) Bonds for infrastructure, property acquisitions, and other improvements for the Northwest-Progresso-Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Area. As of September 1, 2013, the bonds hit final maturity and were paid-in-full; however, there were \$2,850,064.83 in proceeds remaining in the bond accounts. To facilitate the closing of the TIR bond funds, on November 19, 2013, the remaining balance of \$2,850,064.83 was transferred to the CRA operating fund as reimbursement to the fund for other bond eligible expenditures. As part of the closing of the bond funds, projects need to be closed and re-funded where appropriate.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2014 CIP and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the various funds in the amount of \$1,852,275 for the purpose of funding other ongoing projects in the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Redevelopment Area.

E. Transfer between capital projects - Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Redevelopment Area Fund - Business Incentives, General Façade and Sistrunk Lighting Upgrades projects - \$647,982

The Northwest Progresso-Flagler Heights (NWPFH) adopted CIP includes several projects with remaining balances that are recommended to be transferred and the projects closed. The Midtown Façade balance is recommended to be transferred into the General Façade project to consolidate the funding. Remaining funds from the Building Design and Planning Services project, Sistrunk Boulevard Water Main project and the NWPFH projects will be transferred into the Business Incentives project and into a new project, Sistrunk Lighting Upgrades, which is recommended to be funded.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2014 CIP and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Redevelopment Area Funds in the amount of \$647,982.

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# F. Appropriation from fund balance – Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Area CIP Fund - Flagler Drive Greenway and Bicycle Facility, Phase 2 project - \$269,250

On February 18, 2014 (CAM 14-0236), the City of Fort Lauderdale accepted and appropriated a grant in the amount of \$988,402 from the Florida Department of Transportation to complete phase II of the Flagler Drive Greenway and Bicycle Facility project. The scope of the project includes the installation of new pedestrian lighting and sidewalk replacement. Some of these costs are not grant eligible; therefore, additional funding of \$269,250 is recommended from the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Area CIP Fund. This funding request is a companion on this agenda, CAM 14-0245, in which it will be presented to the Community Redevelopment Agency Board of Directors.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2014 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Area CIP Fund in the amount of \$269,250 to facilitate the installation of the pedestrian lighting and sidewalk replacement for the Flagler Drive Greenway and Bicycle Facility project.

# G. Transfer between capital projects - Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Redevelopment Area Fund – streetscape improvements for the Shoppes on Arts Avenue project - \$150,106

Through the Streetscape Grant Program, the City has awarded a 50% reimbursement grant for costs associated streetscape improvements, such as paving, sidewalks, curbing, and landscaping to the Developer of the Shoppes on Arts Avenue retail project. Total cost of the improvements is \$300,212; a 50% reimbursement grant is requested for \$150,106. The funding request was budgeted as a part of the CRA Five-Year Strategic Program by the Community Redevelopment Agency Board of Directors October 15, 2013, CAM 13-1350. The funding request is a companion item on this agenda, CAM 14-0371.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2014 Community Investment Plan (CIP) and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Area Fund in the amount of \$150,106 to facilitate the 50% reimbursement grant awarded to the Developer of the Shoppes on Arts Avenue.

### **Transportation and Mobility**

## H. Transfer of funds from the Oceanside Lot Rehabilitation project to fund balance and closing the project – Parking System Operations Fund - \$92,000

The cost for the Oceanside Lot Rehabilitation was allocated to sealing and striping the

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surface parking lot on the corner of A1A and East Las Olas Blvd. This work has been completed and the project has a remaining balance. The balance of \$92,000.00 is recommended to be transferred to the Parking System Operations fund balance.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2014 CIP and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Parking System Operations Fund in the amount of \$92,000.

# I. Transfer of funds from the Helistop Lot Redevelopment to Public Parking project to fund balance and closing the project – Parking System Operations Fund - \$400,566

The parcel of land located at 130 NW 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue was the City's heliport before relocating to the roof of the City Park Garage. The Transportation and Mobility (TAM) Department had planned to develop the empty lot into a public parking facility. With the rollout of the WAVE project, use of this land will be reallocated. The original funding allocated for this project was \$425,000.00, with \$24,434.42 used to install a security fence enclosing the lot. The balance of these funds, \$400,565.58 is recommended to be transferred to the Parking System Operations fund balance.

Staff recommends that the City Commission amend the FY 2014 CIP and Budget by amending the appropriate accounts in the Parking System Operations in the amount of \$400,565.58.
