Motion to Approve Workers' Compensation Excess Insurance Policy Quote

Mr. Hine advised the Board that the City's workers' compensation insurance policy would be renewing on October 1, 2024. He advised that Paul Dawson of Brown & Brown would be presenting on the policy.

Mr. Dawson advised that after discussions with the City that Brown & Brown requested a renewal with the current carrier, Safety National Casualty Corp., for the upcoming October 1, 2024 – October 1, 2025 policy renewal period.

Mr. Dawson provided the Board with the results of the renewal quote that resulted in a 12% premium increase for this policy year as compared to last if they reselected the current carrier. He advised that the City's premium rate increased by 5% and the City's payroll had increased by 7% which was the reason for the premium increase. In addition, there has been a 5% - 10% increase to keep up with trends in rising medical costs. The premium for the prior year was \$524,336 and the renewal premium will be \$591,592.

The Board proceeded to discuss this item and asked a few questions regarding the policy. Motion by Ted Hess, seconded by Mr. Perrillo, to approve the workers' compensation insurance policy from Safety National Casualty Corp. for a premium of \$591,592. In a voice vote, the motion passed unanimously.
