TITLE:	Motion Approving FY2025 Beach Business Improvement District Funding of the Park Ranger Program - \$9,000 – <b>(Commission District 2)</b>

## **Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission approve \$9,000 in Beach Business Improvement District (BBID) funding to enhance the Park Ranger Program's presence at the Las Olas Oceanside Park (LOOP), and to support DC Alexander Park as needed, during the hightraffic months of January and February 2025.

## **Background**

At the November 18, 2024, BBID Advisory Committee meeting, the Neighbor Support Division and the Fort Lauderdale Police Homeless Outreach Team requested \$9,000 from the BBID to fund the Park Ranger Program in January and February of 2025.

The goal of the program is to:

- 1. Enhance the experience of neighbors and visitors at the LOOP
- 2. Increase visibility of Park Rangers onsite
- 3. Mitigate disruptive behavior from park patrons who may be blocking entrances to restrooms, public indecency, and/or not utilizing the park space for its intended use

The BBID Advisory Committee unanimously recommends approval. Funding for this program will be allocated from the BBID's FY25 budget.

## Funding History

The BBID funded this program in FY24 with a total allocation of \$15,000.

The BBID Assessment is a non-ad valorem assessment for the cost of providing beach business improvements services, facilities and programs that have a special benefit to commercial property located within the beach area. The funding proposals are consistent with the legislative determinations of special benefit found in C-06-34, Section 1.04(A)(2), Fort Lauderdale Code of Ordinances, by increasing the number of visitors to the BBID.
