Broward County, Land Stewardship Program, Parks for People Grant,

Hardy Park, \$75,000, City match required

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the proper city officials to submit a grant application for the Broward County Land Stewardship Program.

## **Background**

The City is requesting a grant in the amount of \$75,000 with a required 1 to 1 cash match. The City has identified matching funds in the amount of \$75,000 from funds previously appropriated in the Special Obligation Bond Fund.

Funds will be used to incorporate "green" amenities into the development of the site, namely towards the purchase and installation of a restroom building and pavilion. This grant is an expansion of the scope of work for the Southside School project, P10777, currently funded at \$1,035,024.

The Broward County Land Stewardship Program announced the availability of Parks for People grant funds on September 17, 2012. The grant application deadline is October 26, 2012. This is the final cycle of this grant program.

Grant funds are available for sites that were acquired through the 2000 Safe Parks and Land Preservation Bond Program; it is a supplemental grant to incorporate "green" standards in the development of bond acquired green space and open space sites. Green standards include features or amenities composed of recycled materials or environmentally sound components.

Amenities must be installed within one year of the execution of agreement. It is anticipated the grant agreement will be received in December 2012. Grant period will be twelve (12) months from the date of execution. Staff is prepared to meet these deadlines. The City's cost share is has previously been appropriated in the capital budget.

## Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the city in the amount of \$75,000 which would allow for project implementation. Matching funds have been identified in existing capital funded projects.
