## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Task Order No. 2 with Miller Legg & Associates, Inc. for engineering services in the not to exceed amount of \$46,825.00.

## **Background**

The City is working diligently with Broward County environmental and legal staff to finalize issues related to the Environmental Resource Licenses issued on December 21, 2007, requiring environmental restoration of Parcels B, C, and D, located north of N.W. 65<sup>th</sup> Street between N.W. 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and N.W. 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

The Airport is continuing the process of clearing and mitigating these parcels for potential development. In order to determine the proper course of action to continue to prepare the property for development, the Airport needs to determine the suitability of the soils within all three parcels. This information will be used to prepare bid specifications to assist with obtaining a contractor to address the condition of the parcels.

Staff has negotiated Task Order No. 2, in an amount not to exceed \$46,825.00, with the City's General Civil Engineering Consultant, Miller Legg & Associates, Inc. The services provided under this task order will include geotechnical and earthwork analysis and preparing bid specifications for the above parcels.

This item was reviewed and approved by the Aviation Advisory Board at its January 24, 2013 meeting.

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## **Resource Impact**

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$46,825.00 for Task Order No. 2.
