TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Purchase of Meter and Valve Setting

Equipment, and Cast Iron Valve Boxes - A & B Pipe and Supply, Inc. -

\$260,682 (two-year total)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a two-year contract, in substantially the form attached, with A & B Pipe and Supply, Inc. for the purchase of meter and valve setting equipment, and cast iron valve boxes in the amount of \$260,682 and authorize the City Manager to approve two, one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

Daily operation and maintenance of the City's 784 miles of water distribution main piping and 62,000 service lines and meters require a constant supply of meter and valve setting equipment and cast iron valve boxes. These parts are used for the installation of water meters and water valves. This contract will be used on an as-needed basis and the cost of the purchases will be charged against individual requisitions to make infrastructure repairs.

On April 28, 2017, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 472-11942. Three bids were received on May 15, 2017. The bids submitted were reviewed for compliance with the specifications of the solicitation. The bid submitted by A & B Pipe and Supply, Inc. has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$25,000, and funds are available in the FY2017 Operating Budget in the accounts listed below. Future year expenditures are contingent upon approval of fiscal year budgets.
