# **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing 1) execution of a Memorandum of Agreement (Exhibit 1); and execution of a Sixth Amendment to Inclusive Landscape Memorandum of Agreement (Exhibit 2).

## **Background**

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is an agreement for the City to maintain specific elements constructed under Project Number 433688-4-52-01 to include decorative light fixtures or poles, a decorative sea wall, LED string lights, and a fiber-optic system servicing the decorative sea wall installed along AIA. These are improvements installed during the reconstruction at A1A related to Tropical Storm Sandy.

In addition, the City entered into an Inclusive Landscape Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement for State Road A1A with FDOT on January 31, 2008. FDOT has decided to construct additional landscape improvements and/or to modify any improvements located at State Road A1A from N.E. 9th Street to just north of N.E. 18th Street. A Sixth Amendment to this agreement requires that the City maintain these improvements.

#### **Resource Impact**

No fiscal impact at this time, as the improvements will not take place for approximately two years.

## **Strategic Connection**
