RESOLUTION NO. 25-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A COMMUNITY AESTHETIC FEATURE AGREEMENT ("CAFA") WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") FOR THE INSTALLATION OF PUBLIC ART AT THE INTERSECTION F A1A AND LAS OLAS BOULEVARD, WITHIN THE FDOT RIGHT OF WAY; AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2022, the City Commission approved the donation of \$5,000,000 from the James Winder Laird Estate (the Estate) to fund the acquisition, installation, and maintenance of public art throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement ("CAFA") grants the City permission to install and maintain the public artwork within Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") right-of-way and outlines the responsibilities and conditions under which the project may proceed; and

WHEREAS, the CAFA also requires the City to provide a \$13,500.00 removal and restoration bond to ensure the site can be returned to its original condition upon termination of the agreement or removal of the artwork.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves the execution of the Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation and authorizes the proper City Officials to execute and deliver the instrument in a similar form as exhibited and presented.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by the City Manager.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That all Resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
