# MODIFICATION #1 TO SUBGRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE CITY OF MIRAMAR

This Modification is made and entered into by and between the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management ("the Division"), and the City of Miramar ("the Recipient") to modify Contract Number: 11-DS-A1-11-16-02-487, which began on October 01, 2010 ("the Agreement").

WHEREAS, the Division and the Recipient have entered into the Agreement, pursuant to which the Division has provided a subgrant to Recipient under the State Homeland Security Grants Program of \$5,885,153.00; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement expires on April 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Division and the Recipient desire to extend the term of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Paragraph 3 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

This Agreement shall begin October 01, 2010 and shall end June 30, 2013, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph (12) of this Agreement.

- 2. All provisions of the Agreement being modified and any attachments in conflict with this Modification shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this Modification, effective on the date of execution of this Modification by both parties.
- 3. All provisions not in conflict with this Modification remain in full force and effect, and are to be performed at the level specified in the Agreement.

## FIRST AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATING FORT LAUDERDALE UASI AGENCIES

This First Amendment to Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort				
Lauderdale UASI Agencies (the "First Amendment") is entered into this day of				
20, by and between the City of Miramar, a municipal corporation of				
the State of Florida (the "Sponsoring Agency") and the City of Fort Lauderdale, a				
Florida Municipality (the "Participating Agency").				

#### **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency entered into a Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies dated October 24, 2011 (the "Primary MOA") related to expenditures of funds allocated in the amount of \$419,978.72 subgranted to the Participating Agency under the FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") Grant Program, the initial term of which was to end on April 30, 2013; and which term has been extended through June 30, 2013 by way of this first amendment approved by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency entered into another Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies dated September 17, 2012 (the "Regional MOA") related to expenditures of funds allocated in the amount of \$56,250.00, subgranted to the Participating Agency under the FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") Grant Program for a regional project to fund: The South Florida Citizen Corps Task Force, to be expended and reimbursed pursuant to the terms of the MOA, the initial term of which was to end on April 30, 2013; and which term has been extended through June 30, 2013 by way of this first amendment approved by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency entered into a third Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies

dated <u>January 22, 2013</u> (the "2<sup>nd</sup> Regional MOA") related to expenditures of funds allocated in the amount of **\$98,159.29**, subgranted to the Participating Agency under the FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") Grant Program for a regional project to fund: <u>interoperable communications trailer radio system and data satellite</u>, to be expended and reimbursed pursuant to the terms of the MOA, the initial term of which was to end on <u>April 30, 2013</u>; and which term has been extended through <u>June 30, 2013</u> by way of this first amendment approved by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the MOA(s) is/are subject to all terms, provisions and conditions of the Federally Funded Subgrant Agreement between the Sponsoring Agency and the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management for FY 2010 (the "State Agreement"), the current term of which will end or has ended on <u>April 30, 2013</u>; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency has applied to the State of Florida for an extension of the term of the State Agreement in order to provide additional time for the completion of procurement and the expenditure of the grant funding available under the FY 2010 UASI Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has agreed, subject to execution of a written contract modification, to reinstate and extend the State Agreement through <u>June 30</u>, <u>2013</u>; and

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to reinstate and extend the term of all referenced MOAs through the same extension date as approved by the State of Florida for the State Agreement, to wit: <u>June 30, 2013</u>, in order to provide additional time for the completion of the procurement process and the expenditure of the grant funding available under the FY 2010 UASI Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. In conjunction with the extension of the State Agreement through <u>June 30, 2013</u>, the term of referenced MOA(s) between the parties shall be reinstated and extended to <u>June 30, 2013</u>.
- 2. All terms, provisions and conditions of the MOA not inconsistent with this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
