

RESOLUTION NO. 19-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND RATIFYING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND THE FEDERATION OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES, A DIVISION OF THE NATIONAL FEDERATION OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE EMPLOYEES, AFL-CIO, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 3, 2019, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Fort Lauderdale and the bargaining agent of the Federation of Public Employees, a division of the National Federation of Public and Private Employees, AFL-CIO, as certified by the Florida Public Employees Relations Commission in Certification Numbers 1521 and 1523, ("Federation of Public Employees"), have reached an agreement on a proposed collective bargaining agreement effective December 3, 2019, through September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale employees who are members of the collective bargaining units represented by the Federation of Public Employees have ratified the proposed collective bargaining agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the Federation of Public Employees, effective December 3, 2019, through September 30, 2022, is approved and ratified in substantially the form attached to Commission Agenda Memo No. 19-1174, and the City Commission authorizes execution of the collective bargaining agreement.
