Association to Help Fund the NE 2nd Street Parking and Drainage

Improvement Project (P11938)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission accept \$15,000 from the Pine Crest Village Association to help fund the NE 2nd Street Parking and Drainage Improvement Project (P11938).

Background

To alleviate drainage and parking issues in the area, the City is advancing the NE 2nd Street Parking and Drainage Improvement Project along NE 2nd Street on the north side of the Pine Crest Village complex using a system of permeable articulating concrete block mats. This technology allows for infiltration and storage of stormwater. The total construction cost of the project is \$60,000, with funding from the stormwater and parking funds. The Association has offered to contribute \$15,000 towards the project, conditioned on completion according to the scope (**Exhibit 1**).

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City by accepting this contribution. The consolidated budget amendment CAM #14-0905 is a companion item to this request.
