TITLE: Motion to reject all bids for polymer pumps and motors – Invitation to Bid
(ITB) 442-11399

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission reject all bids for the purchase of polymer pumps and motors.

Background

On March 17, 2014 the Procurement Services Division issued an ITB and received three responses. Subsequently, it was discovered that the model number of the pumps listed was not correct for the equipment needed by the City. After bid opening, the manufacturer notified the City that the polymer pumps and motors can only be purchased directly from the manufacturer as a proprietary item. Staff is in the process of obtaining a quotation from the manufacturer and will bring a recommendation for purchase to the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City.
