TITLE: Motion Accepting Donation of Dog Waste Station Equipment from the Rio
Vista Civic Association - **(Commission District 4)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Commission approves a motion authorizing the City Manager to accept a dog waste station equipment donation from the Rio Vista Civic Association and to execute any documents required to accept the donation between the Rio Vista Civic Association and the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Background

The Rio Vista Civic Association is requesting approval to donate equipment to the Fort Lauderdale Parks & Recreation Department for the installation of a dog waste station at Hector Park. City staff estimate the value of the dog waste station at \$300.

Resource Impact

The donation value of the equipment is approximately \$300.
