- TITLE: Motion Approving an Agreement with the City of Coral Springs, Florida Regional Institute of Public Safety, to Allow Student Ride Alongs with the City of Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue Department - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Commission approve a five-year agreement, in substantially the form attached, with the City of Coral Springs, Florida Regional Institute of Public Safety (CSRIPS) allowing Paramedic and Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) students to ride along with City of Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue Department paramedics to gain practical experience.

Background

CSRIPS is conducting educational programs through its EMS Programs for the purpose of providing skilled workers for the health service industry. This agreement will commence on April 1, 2024 and conclude on April 1, 2029.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City.
