Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the appropriate City official or staff to negotiate a contract of employment as City Attorney with the candidate selected by the City Commission. The selected candidate will be determined by a vote of the Commission.

Background

A City Attorney Search Committee was established at a City Commission meeting on March 23, 2023. The Committee conducted 6 meetings, reviewed resumes, and interviewed 3 candidates on September 18, 2023. The Committee provided their recommendations of 2 candidates that it determined meets the qualifications for the City Attorney position and advanced those candidates to City Commission, via City Manager's Memo No. 23-117 for consideration.
