for the installation of one (1) boat lift – (Commission District 1)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution approving a Waiver of Limitations for the installation of one (1) boat lift located at 2765 NE 14th Street.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow piles to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 C of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the installation of one (1) boat lift extending a maximum of 31.0'+/- from the property line into the adjacent waters of the Rio Encarnado Canal.

The applicant's Summary Description specifies that the proposed structure is necessary for safely mooring vessels, especially during high wind events and severe weather, and to protect vessel from high wave energy from excessive wakes.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$1500 is required.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended approval of the application (12:0) (see Exhibit 3) at the October 5, 2023 MAB meeting.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$1,500. Revenue related to the application fee is included in the FY2022 Operating Budget in the account listed below.
