TITLE: Resolution Approving an Amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for the Construction of Runway 9-27 Pavement Rehabilitation Project at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport - \$87,485 - **(Commission District 1)**

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a resolution approving an Amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement (PTGA) and accepting the anticipated grant funding of up to \$87,485 for the Construction of Runway 9-27 Pavement Rehabilitation Project at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and authorize the City Manager to execute an Amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement.

Background

The Runway 9-27 Pavement Rehabilitation project is required as part of the Airport's approved Airport Layout Plan (ALP) to improve the current pavement condition of Runway 9-27 and taxiway intersections. Runway 9-27 is reaching its 20-year useful life and has a weighted Pavement Condition Index (PCI) value of 50 per Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Airport Pavement Evaluation Report of FXE.

Based on the original engineer estimated project cost of \$8,814,229, FDOT provided a PTGA in the amount of \$440,711 for up to 5% of the estimated construction costs. The acceptance of the grant and associated Airport grant match of \$440,711 was recommended for approval by the Aviation Advisory Board on December 7, 2023, and the City Commission approved the grant agreement on January 9, 2024 (CAM 24-0022).

Subsequently, the estimated project cost increased by \$1,749,700, bringing the revised project cost to \$10,563,929. The increased cost is a result of the contractor bids received for the project, which was higher than anticipated. As a result of the increased project cost, FDOT has provided an Amendment to the PTGA for an additional \$87,485 in grant funding which brings the total grant contribution to \$528,196. The Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP) grant will provide the total amount of up to \$8,800,000 (CAM #24-0796) and the remaining amount of \$1,235,733 is available in the Airport fund.

At its meeting of December 5, 2024, the Aviation Advisory Board supported staff's recommendation to accept the additional grant funds from the FDOT.

Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City for the grant in the amount of \$87,485. These appropriations are contingent upon the approval of the January 7, 2025, Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 24-1167.



B. Project Location (limits, city, county, map): Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport/Fort Lauderdale, FL/Broward

C. Project Scope (allowable costs: describe project components, improvement type/service type, approximate timeline, project schedule, project size): As required by 215.971, F.S., this scope of work includes but is not limited to consultant and design fees, the survey and geotechnical costs, construction inspection and material testing costs, mobilization and demobilization, permitting, pavement demolition, surface course improvements (such as concrete, asphalt, rejuvenators, or sealants), joint construction, runway grooving, pavement markings and striping, airfield lighting and signage improvements, recalculation of the pavement PCN, updating the new PCN numbers on the FAA Form 5010 and the FAD, sodding, and safety barricades, including all materials, equipment, labor, and incidentals required to rehabilitate the runway pavement. The Sponsor will comply with Aviation Program Assurances.

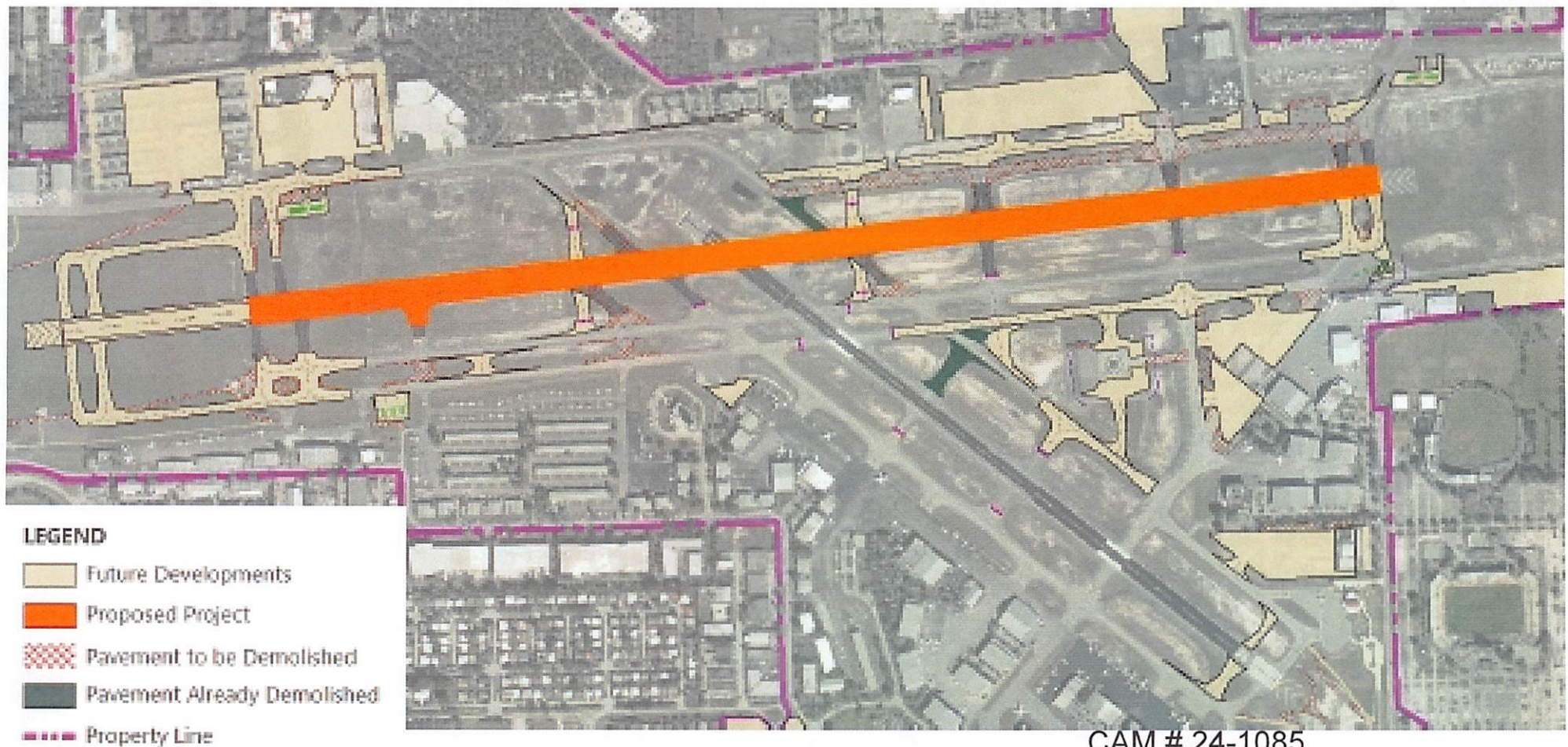
D. Deliverable(s):

The project scope identifies the ultimate project deliverables. Deliverables for requisition, payment and invoice purposes will be the incremental progress made toward completion of project scope elements. Supporting documentation will be quantifiable, measurable, and verifiable, to allow for a determination of the amount of incremental progress that has been made, and provide evidence that the payment requested is commensurate with the accomplished incremental progress and costs incurred by the Agency.

E. Unallowable Costs (including but not limited to):

F. Transit Operating Grant Requirements (Transit Only):

Transit Operating Grants billed as an operational subsidy will require an expenditure detail report from the Agency that matches the invoice period. The expenditure detail, along with the progress report, will be the required deliverables for Transit Operating Grants. Operating grants may be issued for a term not to exceed three years from execution. The original grant agreement will include funding for year one. Funding for years two and three will be added by amendment as long as the grantee has submitted all invoices on schedule and the project deliverables for the year have been met.

WHEREAS, the project is for the construction costs of the Runway 9-27 Pavement Rehabilitation project at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport ("FXE") which was estimated to cost \$8,814,229.00 (Eight Million Eight Hundred Fourteen Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty-Nine Dollars and 00/100 cents); and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2024, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City"), adopted Resolution No. 24-02 approving a Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for the Runway 9-27 Pavement Rehabilitation Project at FXE; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of the project increased by One Million Seven Hundred Forty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred dollars and 00/100 cents (\$1,749,700.00), bringing the amended total cost of the project to Ten Million Five Hundred Sixty-three Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-nine dollars and 00/100 cents (\$10,563,929.00); and

WHEREAS, the increased cost is a result of the City receiving bid prices that were higher than anticipated for the project; and

WHEREAS, FDOT has agreed to increase its grant funding by Eighty-seven Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-five dollars and 00/100 cents (\$87,485.00) to fund a maximum of up to Five Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand One Hundred Ninety-six Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$528,196.00) of the total eligible project cost; and

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2024, the Aviation Advisory Board supported staff's recommendation to accept the additional grant amount from FDOT; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that approving the Amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement and acceptance of the additional grant funds is in the best interest of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves the Amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation, for the additional project costs associated with the Runway 9-27 Pavement Rehabilitation project at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport, Financial Project Number 451503-1-94-01, and the City Manager is authorized to execute the Amendment to the Public Transportation Grant Agreement on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept additional grant funds on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale from the Florida Department of Transportation in the amount of Eighty-seven Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-five dollars and 00/100 cents (\$87,485.00) for a total maximum amount of up to Five Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand One Hundred Ninety-six Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$528,196.00) for the Runway 9-27 Pavement Rehabilitation project at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport.

SECTION 4. The Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by proper City officials.

SECTION 5. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6. If any clause, section, or other part of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such unconstitutional or invalid part shall be considered as eliminated and shall in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage and adoption.


