

RESOLUTION NO. 26-116

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH BARRY UNIVERSITY, INC. FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES STUDENT RIDE TIME TRAINING WITH THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT, DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AND PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Barry University, Inc. currently maintains an agreement with the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("City"), that allows students enrolled in EMS programs to complete required field ride time training with Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue; and

WHEREAS, this partnership has been in place for several years and has provided students with valuable hands-on clinical and operational experience in a real-world emergency response environment; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement is set to expire in June of 2026; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement will allow the continuation of this long-standing training partnership and support the development of future EMS professionals; and

WHEREAS, Barry University will provide a total of one tuition scholarship annually for the paramedic program to any City employee that chooses to attend their program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, approves the agreement with Barry University, Inc. for Emergency Medical Services Student Ride Time Training with the City of Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue Department, and delegates to the City Manager the authority to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.

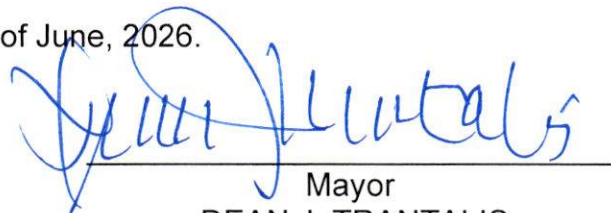
SECTION 2. That any resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
