**TITLE:** Motion Approving Consent Assignment of Contract from Home Depot USA  
to HD Supply Facilities Maintenance, Ltd - (**Commission Districts 1, 2, 3  
and 4**)

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**Recommendation**

Staff recommends the City Commission consents to the assignment of contract, in substantially the form attached, for janitorial supplies from Home Depot U.S.A. (“Home Depot”), Inc. to HD Supply Facilities Maintenance, Ltd.

**Background**

On December 5, 2017, the City of Fort Lauderdale (“City”) entered into an Agreement with Interline Brands, Inc. (“Interline”) pursuant to Contract 17-21, Janitorial Supplies, as awarded by the Fresno Unified School District (“Fresno”) via the U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance. On February 3, 2019, Interline Brands, Inc, legally merged with Home Depot. Thereafter, Home Depot, as the surviving corporation after merger with Interline, entered into an assignment of contract with HD Supply Facilities Maintenance, Ltd., whereby Home Depot assigned its tangible and intangible assets to HD Supply Facilities Maintenance, Ltd., including the City’s “piggyback” contract with Home Depot for janitorial supplies. Fresno has approved Home Depot’s assignment of contract.

Home Depot served the City with notice of its assignment of contract with HD Supply Facilities Maintenance, Ltd. and requests the City Commission’s consideration and approval of the subject assignment of contract.

**Resource Impact**
