A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES TO ACCEPT AND RECEIVE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,170 FROM THE FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION, SAFETY DATA IMPROVEMENT PROJECT GRANT PROGRAM AND AMENDING THE FINAL OPERATING BUDGET OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2013, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2014, BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS AS SET FORTH IN CITY COMMISSION AGENDA MEMO #14-0349

WHEREAS, the City submitted an application to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles for funding under the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's Safety Data Improvement Project Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the overall goal of the grant is to assist law enforcement agencies in increasing their use of e-crash reporting; and

WHEREAS, grant funds will be used to purchase six (6) tablet computers to implement electronic reporting of commercial motor vehicle crashes; and

WHEREAS, the grant has a two (2) year period of performance which commences on the grant contract's date of full execution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 13-168, adopted on September 12, 2013, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale adopted the Final Operating Budget of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2013, and ending September 30, 2014,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles accepting grant funds in the amount of \$22,170.
