TITLE: Charter Amendment, November 6, 2012, General Election – Sale of Surplus City-Owned Property for Affordable Housing or Economic Development Purposes.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve on second reading an ordinance amending Ordinance C-11-36.

Background

The proposed ordinance amends Ordinance No. C-11-36 to change the referendum date of a ballot measure to November 6, 2012. If approved by the voters, the measure will add Section 8.22 to the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, to provide for the sale of surplus city-owned real property for affordable housing or economic development purposes without the necessity of establishing a minimum acceptable value or competitive bidding upon unanimous vote of the City Commission.

The City Attorney recommends the introduction of the ordinance on second reading.
