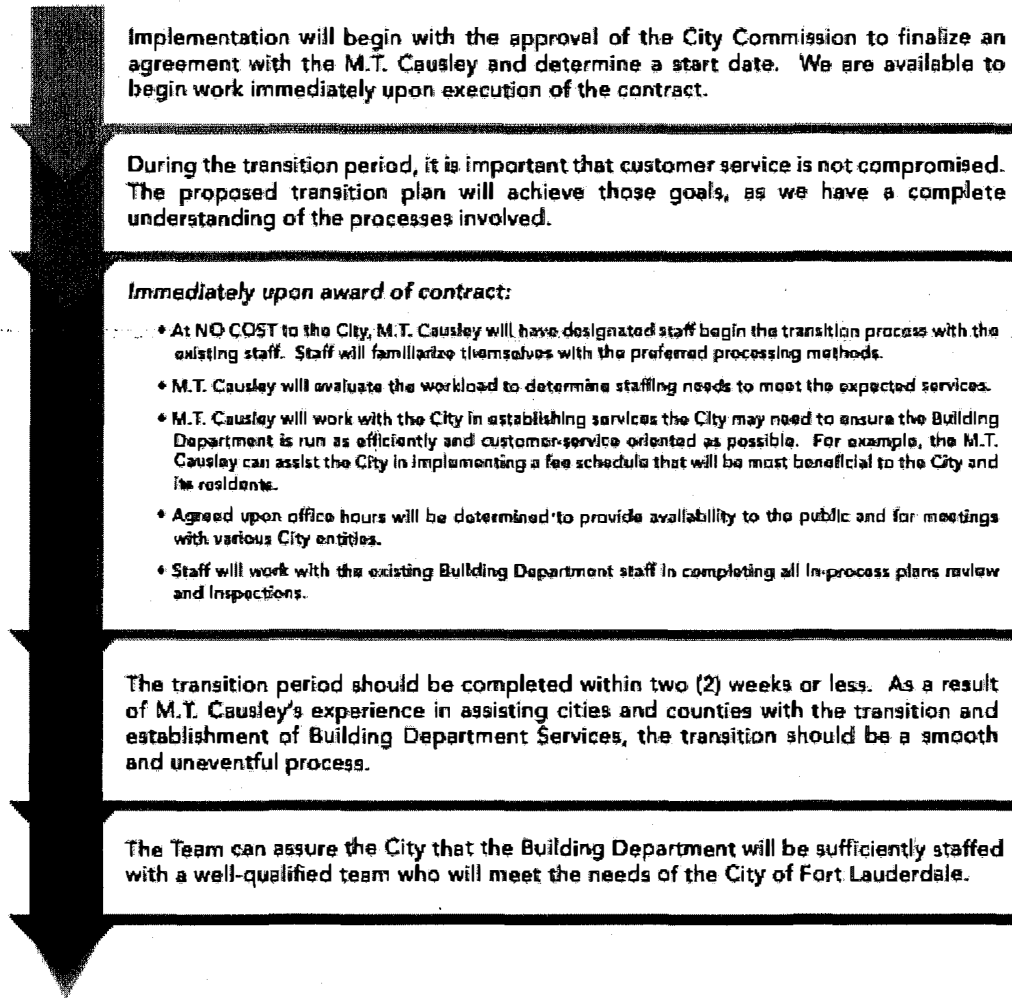


Figure 1. Transition Timeline
