TITLE: Motion to approve first contract extension for concrete, stamped asphalt
and paver brick repairs – Contract 223-11030 – \$236,946

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a one-year extension to the contract for concrete, stamped asphalt and paver brick repairs with Straightline Engineering Group, LLC in substantially the form attached.

Background

On August 21, 2012, the City Commission approved an initial two-year contract for concrete, stamped asphalt and paver brick repairs with Straightline Engineering Group, LLC (CAM 12-1205). This project is for repair of broken sidewalk, curb, gutter, pavers, and stamped asphalt. Some work may require trimming and cutting of tree roots. The effort is meant to maintain the City's public roads and pedestrian facilities. In accordance with the terms of the contract, three one-year contract extensions are allowed. This request is for the first contract extension approval.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the city in the current fiscal year in the amount of \$236,946 for the contract and \$40,500 for engineering fees, for a total amount of \$277,446.
