TITLE: Ordinance Amending Section 2-199 of the Code of Ordinances Relating to
the Procedure for the Purchase of Insurance and Insurance-Related
Services

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt the attached ordinance amending the Code of Ordinance to revise and streamline the process of purchasing insurance and insurance-related services.

Background

Currently, Section 2-199, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, requires that the Commission approve the use of the negotiation process to purchase insurance when negotiation is industry accepted and the most cost effective method of purchasing insurance. This ordinance change allows the use of the negotiation method without Commission approval but continues to require Commission approval of the final purchase.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City.
