TITLE: Motion to approve the proprietary purchase of annual support for Hewlett-Packard hardware and software - \$61,300.64

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of proprietary annual support for Hewlett-Packard hardware and software from Hewlett-Packard Company in the amount of \$61,300.64.

Background

This is a request for approval for maintenance and support of the City’s Hewlett-Packard hardware and software. The City utilizes a variety of Hewlett-Packard equipment and operating system software. There are three high-end servers that support many of our critical software applications (Community Plus, Payroll, and Utility Billing). We also have a Hewlett-Packard “blade server” hardware and software system (for virtual server capabilities), disk storage, and an uninterruptable power supply (UPS). The cost of this year’s annual support renewal, which provides telephone, electronic and on-site technical support is \$61,300.64.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$61,300.64.
