**TITLE:** Motion to reject all bids for the NW Second Avenue Storage Tank Rehabilitation project – P11405

---

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission reject all bids for the NW Second Avenue Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation project.

**Background**

The bid package for the rehabilitation and painting of the NW Second Avenue Elevated Water Storage Tank included rehabilitation and repair for the tank to meet current Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requirements, and to paint the interior and exterior of the tank. However, it did not include the items below:

- Decorative painting scheme for the tank
- Decorative fence; and
- Site landscaping

Therefore, it is recommended rejecting the bids to include the items on the new bid documents for the project and rebid the project.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the City for rejecting all the bids.
