Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a three month contract extension for the purchase of aggregates through Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (Co-Op) Contract 2010-012 to Soil Tech Distributors, Inc. and Austin Tupler Trucking, Inc. in the estimated three month amount of \$56,500.

Background

The Public Works Department purchases road rock for the repair of the water, stormwater, and sewage distribution systems and Parks and Recreation Department uses top soils and sands for parks maintenance.

Co-Op contract 2010-012 was scheduled to expire on July 2, 2013. The City of Margate, as lead agency, is in the process of soliciting new bids to create a new Co-Op contract for aggregates. This process was delayed, requiring their Commission to extend the contract for three months. On behalf of the Co-Op, on May 15, 2013, Resolution Number 13-326, the City Commission for the City of Margate extended contract 2010-012 thru September 30, 2013.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$56,500.
