Order No. 31 in the amount of \$20,775.00, and Work Order No. 32 in the amount of \$3,800.00, under the Annual Concrete and Brick Pavers

Contract with Straightline Engineering Group, LLC - P11762

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve these three (3) Work Orders in the aggregate amount of \$26,794.00 under the two year Annual Concrete and Brick Pavers Contract with Straightline Engineering Group, LLC., approved by City Commission on August 21, 2012.

Background

In compliance with Section 2-179(5) of the City Code of Ordinances, all work orders under any annual contract in a cumulative amount over \$25,000.00 must be brought back to the City Commission for review and approval.

Work Order No. 30, in the amount of \$2,219.00, is for the restoration of sidewalks following new water mains and water meter boxes being installed in the Lake Ridge Neighborhood.

Work Order No. 31, in the amount of \$20,775.00, is for sidewalk and paver brick restoration, Citywide. The work includes sidewalk repair due to trip and fall claims (\$1,900.00), sidewalk and paver brick restoration following utility repairs (\$2,219.00), ADA ramp replacement, curb replacement, paver brick repairs in crosswalks along roadways under City, County and State jurisdiction (\$12,396.00), and sidewalk repair costs which will be paid by residents (\$4,260.00).

Work Order No. 32, in the amount of \$3,800.00, is for sidewalk and two ADA ramps at Northwest 24th Avenue and Northwest 11th Street in Dillard Park.

Please note, currently under the City Code of Ordinances, sidewalk repairs are the property owner's responsibility with the exception of:

• Where trip and fall claims are reported to Risk Management;

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- Where utility repair displaces concrete sidewalk or paver brick driveways;
- Paver brick replacement in crosswalk for roadways under City jurisdiction;
- State or County jurisdiction where maintenance agreements assign repair responsibility to the City.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$31,294.00. This amount includes \$26,794.00 for the Work Orders and \$4,500.00 for associated engineering fees.
