Limitations at 1801 SE 21st Avenue for the Installation of one (1) Boat Lift

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission adopt a Resolution approving a Waiver of Limitations for the installation of one (1) boat lift located at 1801 SE 21st Avenue.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow a mooring structure to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 C of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the installation of one (1) boat lift extending a maximum of 67'8" +/- from the applicant's westernmost platted upland property line into the Intracoastal Waterway (ICW). The applicant also owns submerged lands west of the westernmost platted property line, with submerged, and extending between 65'+/- and 75'+/- into the ICW.

The applicant's Summary Description specifies that the proposed structure is necessary for protecting owner's vessel from excessive boat wakes, high winds, and severe weather.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$1500 is required.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended approval of the application 12:0 (see Exhibit 3) at the April 4, 2024 MAB meeting.
