TITLE: Motion to award a contract for the purchase of tennis court resurfacing –

Invitation to Bid (ITB) 542-11410 - \$89,551

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract for tennis court resurfacing to Fast-Dry Courts, Inc. utilizing the City's Contract (Form P-0001) in substantially the form attached not to exceed the amount of \$89,551.

Background

The Parks and Recreation Department has numerous tennis courts throughout the City. The 18 clay courts at Jimmy Evert Tennis Center (JETC) must be resurfaced approximately every 3 years. We are proposing the resurfacing of the tennis courts at JETC, as these courts were last resurfaced in the fall of 2011. JETC hosts several tournaments each year that include the United States Tennis Association (USTA) National Open Clay Court Championships, the USTA National Boys 14 Clay Court Championships and the American Tennis Association National Championships. Over 80,000 people play on these courts annually.

Invitation to Bid 542-11410 was opened on April 29, 2014 with two bids received. The low bidder, Fast Dry Courts, Inc., has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed as a responsive and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$89,551.
