TITLE: Motion Approving an Agreement for Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 484-2 – East Broward Boulevard at SE 15 Avenue Intersection Improvements – Heavy Civil Inc. – \$199,480.62 – (**Commission District 4**)

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for the East Broward Boulevard at SE 15 Avenue Intersection Improvements, with Heavy Civil Inc., in the amount of \$199,480.62, which includes a \$12,000 contingency for unforeseen conditions.

Background

To improve traffic flow and reduce congestion in the City of Fort Lauderdale, the City, via the Transportation and Mobility Department, has planned improvements to critical areas and pinch points throughout the city. The Broward Boulevard Dual Left Lane at SE 15 Avenue Project was developed in coordination with the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division to redesign the northbound turning lane configuration to increase capacity, similar to the recently implemented dual left turn project located at the intersection of Las Olas Boulevard and SE 15 Avenue.

The project is located at the intersection of East Broward Boulevard and SE 15 Avenue. The scope of work includes lane modifications, roadway and pavement work, signing and pavement markings, signal modifications, concrete, and landscape improvements.

On June 20, 2025, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 484-2 – East Broward Boulevard at SE 15 Avenue Intersection Improvements, seeking bids from qualified contractors to provide construction services for the project.

Two (2) addenda were issued to extend the bid opening date from July 16, 2025, to July 23, 2025, and then to July 31, 2025. The City received bids from the following two (2) firms in response to the solicitation:

- Heavy Civil Inc.
- Florida Blacktop, Inc.

Staff reviewed the two (2) bids for compliance with the solicitation requirements. Heavy Civil Inc. was deemed the low, responsive, and responsible bidder. Therefore, Heavy Civil Inc. is recommended for award.

Funds for this agreement in the amount of \$199,480.62 are available in the account listed below contingent upon approval of the November 4, 2025 Consolidated Budget Amendment (CAM #25-0931).
