Declarant owns and intends to develop approximately 1.38 acres of land, generally located east of South Federal Highway and south of Southeast 14th Court, in the City (the "Overall Site"), including a portion of the Overall Site more particularly described in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Property").
- B. Declarant has submitted an application to the City to rezone the Property from RMM-25 (Residential Multifamily Mid Rise/Medium High Density District) to B-1 (Boulevard Business) (the "Application").
- C. In connection with the ultimate development of the Overall Site, the Declarant may construct an automobile dealership on the Overall Site.

- D. The Declarant has voluntary agreed to record this Declaration to limit the allowable uses on the Property as described in **Exhibit "B"** attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Allowable Uses").

NOW, THEREFORE, the Declarant hereby declares that the Property shall be owned, held, used, transferred, sold, conveyed, demised, and occupied subject to the covenants, restrictions, and regulations hereinafter set forth, all of which shall run with such Property and any part thereof and which shall be binding upon all parties having any right, title, or interest in such Property or any part thereof, including, if applicable, their heirs, successors, and assigns.

- Section 1. <u>Recitations</u>. The above recitals are true, complete and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by this reference.
- Section 2. <u>Use of Property</u>. The Property may be used in accordance with those uses described in Exhibit "B" and in accordance with all other applicable land development code requirements. - Section 3. <u>Amendments</u>. This Declaration shall not be modified, amended, or released, except by written instrument, executed by the then owner or owners of the Property and the City. Said document must be recorded in the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.
- Section 4. <u>Recordation and Effective Date</u>. This instrument shall not become effective and shall not be recorded in the Public Records of Broward County, Florida until after approval by the City of the Application, and the expiration of all appeal periods applicable to such approval, or if an appeal is filed, at the denial of such appeal with the Application, as approved, remaining in full force and effect. Once recorded, this Declaration shall run with the Property for the sole benefit of the City and shall bind all successors in interest to the title of the Property.
- Section 5. <u>Severability</u>. The covenants contained herein are hereby declared to be severable and independent. If any Court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any section, paragraph or part thereof invalid or unenforceable, then such judgment or decree shall have no effect on the enforcement or validity of any other section, paragraph or part hereof, and the same shall remain in full force and effect.
