

RESOLUTION NO. 23-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF REQUIRED IMPROVEMENTS BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR THE POLICE HEADQUARTERS; GUARANTEEING CONSTRUCTION OF THE OBLIGATIONS SET FORTH IN THE AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission approved the Fort Lauderdale Police Headquarters Plat on August 16, 2022 (Case Number UDP-P22003) and the Broward County Commission approved the Plat on May 2, 2023, with conditions from the Broward County Highway and Construction Engineering Division requiring the installation of roadway improvements; and

WHEREAS, prior to the recording of the Plat by the City of Fort Lauderdale, the City Commission must approve a Resolution agreeing to construct the improvements prior to issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy and approve the Installation of Required Improvements Agreement with the County regarding roadways improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves the Installation of Required Improvements Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Broward County for the installation of required improvements prior to the issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby guarantees performance of the construction obligations set forth in the Installation of Required Improvements Agreement.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby authorizes the City Officials to execute the Installation of Required Improvements Agreement between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale.

SECTION 4. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City Officials.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage.
