WHEREAS, at its Workshop on February 20, 2024, the City Commission discussed the City of Fort Lauderdale's proposed 2024-26 Federal Legislative Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission hereby approves the City of Fort Lauderdale 2024-26 Federal Legislative Program as set forth in Exhibit 1 to City Commission Agenda Memo No. 24-0577.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Manager is authorized to approve any subsequent changes to the City's 2024-26 Federal Legislative Program for the duration of the 118th United States Congress through the 120th United States Congress.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That the City Manager is delegated the authority to approve grant applications and to enter into agreements on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale related to the City's 2024-26 Federal Legislative Program.
