**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a resolution authorizing the Fire-Rescue Department of the City of Fort Lauderdale to perform routine transfers and authorize the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City.

**Background**

On January 17, 2012, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 12-14, authorizing the Fire-Rescue Department to perform interfacility transfers between two facilities licensed by the State of Florida. The Fire-Rescue Department's Class 2—ALS Transfer license also authorizes the Department to perform routine transfers. In addition to interfacility transfers, routine transfers encompass those that originate or terminate at a patient's residence.

**Resource Impact**

There is a positive fiscal impact to the city in the amount to be determined by the number of transports provided. Projected routine transfer revenue is budgeted for FY 2013 at \$1,340,137.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE FIRE-RESCUE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE TO PERFORM ROUTINE TRANSFER SERVICES.
